INVITATION TO BE PART OF A BUSINESS DELEGATION TO CHINA'S NUCLEAR INDUSTRY SCHEDULED TO TAKE PLACE FROM 20 -28 MARCH 2015.

Dear Sir/Madam

In preparation for the Nuclear Power Plant (NPP) Program in South Africa the dti, in collaboration with the Nuclear Industry Association of South Africa (NIASA) is proud to invite your company to participate in a Nuclear Energy Outward Investment Mission to China; scheduled to take place from 20-28 March 2015.

The Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) 2010-30 was promulgated in March 2011. It was indicated at the time that the IRP should be a "living plan" which would be revised by the Department of Energy (DoE) every two years i.e. an Update was prepared in 2013. Since the promulgation of the Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) 2010-30 there have been a number of developments in the energy sector in South and Southern Africa. In addition the electricity demand outlook has changed markedly from that expected in 2010.

When viewed in conjunction with the dti's stated plans to localize the manufacturing of products and components for the nuclear build program, it becomes crucial for the South African industry to engage counterpart companies in the spirit of a future know-how and technology transfer before the start of the construction of the future South African nuclear fleet thus allowing local industry to participate from the onset.

The objectives of the South African companies on the Nuclear Energy Outward Investment Mission to the China will be as follows:

- the dti envisage that the planned mission to China, could lead to the formation of partnerships that could enhance the mutual benefit of both countries as South Africa prepares for the Nuclear Power Plant (NPP) Program.
- The South African delegation anticipates exploring investment/joint venture opportunities and interaction with the Chinese companies who have been involved with the China - NPP fleet program.

Cost implications:

Participants are to cover their own travel cost and accommodation expenses; however the dti can assist a limited number of companies with travel cost and accommodation subject to approval according to EMIA's (Export Marketing and Investment Assistance) rules and regulations. Should interest prove more than the available number, companies will go through an internal selection process to determine EMIA assistance.
